BBTS Receives Approval for Dry Slope Venue!

Waterville Valley's Black & Blue Trail Smashers Snowsports Club (BBTS) received approval from the Town of Waterville Valley's Planning Board to construct a year-round Dry Slope Venue and BagJump at the base of Snow's Mountain on the Waterville Valley Academy campus. Purchased last fall, the BBTS BagJump is a 50' x 50' x 15' multi-chambered, high-tech airbag apparatus used for absorbing the impact of landings. BagJump made its debut on snow last winter at the ski area. BBTS is the first organization in the east to use the BagJump for training AND will be the first in New England to have a Dry Slope Venue! The BagJump will be positioned at the base of a 220' dry slope on Snow's Mountain. The dry slope will be composed of an artificial snow surface with a take-off platform at the top and a jump platform, featuring multiple jumps, at the bottom.
